

## IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

1. Single admission form can be used by applying to any three disciplines for admission in a relevant subject.
2. Candidates awaiting their HSSC Part-II (2nd year) or 3rd year in case of diploma results are eligible to apply based on their 1st/2nd year marks. Such admission shall be conditional; subject to confirmation if candidates meet minimum criteria of admission in a discipline upon declaration of final results by the concerned Board.
3. Results awaited candidates shall update their marks on CMS/online portal if HSSC/equivalent results are declared before display of initial merit lists on university website/ departmental notice boards.
4. Results awaited candidates must submit a hope/surety certificate issued by the head of their last attended college/institute; or the departments concerned shall obtain a written declaration from the results-awaited candidates to the effect that they will obtain the minimum required percentage in the 2nd year, and in case of failure, their admission shall stand cancelled.
5. The provisional admission shall stand cancelled if results-awaited students fail in any paper or secure less than the minimum required percentage in HSSC/equivalent certificate/diploma. The total admission/tuition fee shall be refunded to such candidates.
6. Candidates having 3<sup>rd</sup> division or less than 45% marks in HSSC are not eligible. Age limit for admission in BS programs is 22 years where female candidates are exempted from the bar of age
7. The candidates with a gap of more than four calendar year from passing FA/ FSC are equivalent examination shall not be allowed for admission in any discipline
8. There shall be 2% quota for minorities (over and above), one seat each for other provinces, Hafiz- e- Quran, disabled, foreign students and sports.
9. Students are requested to visit the university official website regularly for information
10. For LLB -5 Year program applicant(s) must have qualified LAT test
11. For BS Software engineering the applicant(s) shall produce a valid ETEA test result.
12. Applicant must bring original documents along with attached photocopies at the time of admission / interview.
