The Rhodes Scholarship is a fully-funded postgraduate award which enables talented young people from around the world to study full-time at the University of Oxford.

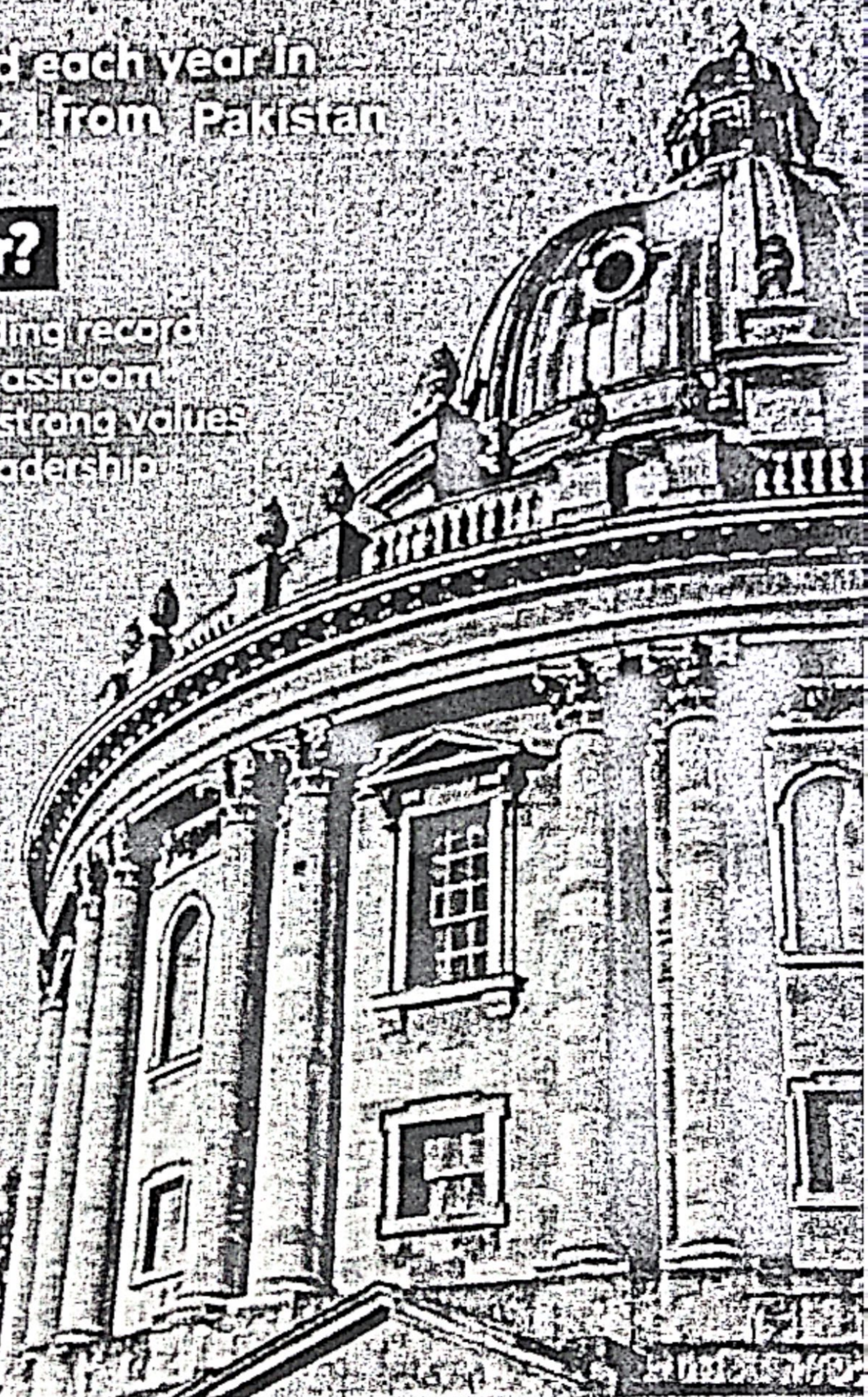
Over 100 students are selected each year in 25 constituencies, including 2 from Pakistan.

What are we looking for?

- Academic achievement & outstanding record
- Pursuit of excellence beyond the classroom
- Commitment to service guided by strong values
- The courage & skills required for leadership

Are you eligible?

- Must fulfil citizenship & residency requirements for your constituency
- Age limits vary by constituency, ranging from 18-24 up to 27 years in exceptional circumstances
- Must have completed (or will complete) an undergraduate degree with a GPA equivalent to 3.7/4.0 or higher

How to apply?

Detailed information on eligibility criteria, application guidelines, and references is available on the official Pakistan Rhodes Scholarship [website](#).

The application process is rigorous, requiring an outstanding academic record, thoughtful and compelling personal statements, and strong institutional endorsements (references).

Shortlisted candidates from Pakistan will be invited to an interview before a national selection committee, where they will be expected to articulate with clarity and conviction their academic ambitions, service and leadership work, and long-term vision for contributing to society.

Even for those who are not ultimately selected, the Rhodes application process is an excellent opportunity to develop and refine applications for leading graduate programmes worldwide.
